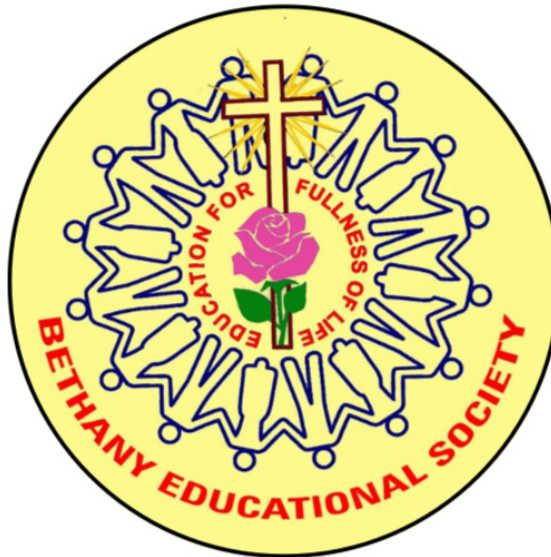

### *Excerpts from Fratelli Tutti by Pope Francis*

As the world faced the Covid-19 pandemic, Pope Francis said, “we must remember that we are not saved alone. Rather, we must extend our hands to celebrate our unity in diversity—unity, not uniformity. The time of fraternity has arrived. Let us counter the many threatening signs, times of darkness and mindsets of conflict with the sign of fraternity that, in accepting others and respecting their identity, invites them to a shared journey.

The world can live in harmony, since we are all creatures of God: brothers and sisters. Our resolve is to walk side by side, ‘brothers and sisters all’, in order to be effective artisans of peace and justice, in the harmony of differences and with respect for the identity of each.
